

## Dutch International Flute Competition

For bachelor and master students, young talents and piccolo students

### List of compulsory pieces 2025

#### Information about your video recording in the preliminary round:

The preliminary rounds of the competition take place online. Please send a link of your videorecording to: [secretaryflutecompetition@gmail.com](mailto:secretaryflutecompetition@gmail.com) before **February 1st**.

- You are requested to submit one **single, unedited videorecording** with your piece for flute and piano and your piece for flute solo
- The two pieces may be recorded at different times and/or locations and at a later time linked up to **one video**.
- You must not exceed the **performance time** of including the breaks in between.
- You must record from a fixed camera standpoint, with horizontal image and a **frontal point of view**. Ensure that the piano and the pianist can be seen also.
- You should ensure the video is filmed indoors and has a **neutral background**, without visible personal belongings.
- You start your video recording by clearly mentioning in English **your name and the pieces** you are going to play.
- If you have given us permission, your video recording may be **published** on our website and our social media on March 1st onwards.

From February 1 through March 1 our adjudicators will adjudicate the video recordings. Rating scores will be given for both **musicality and technique**. Each participant is adjudicated by 3 adjudicators. They will give points from 6 to 10 and up to 1 decimal each. The maximum score will therefore be 60 points. The highest total scores determine who will be shortlisted for the next round.

No later than **March 1st** you will receive an e-mail whether or not you are shortlisted for the next round and in which range of rating you have ended in the preliminary round. Each individual adjudicator will write down some feedback on which you might study in the future.

**Category master students:**

**Online 1st round:**

**Category young talents:**

The maximum playing time is **20 minutes** including the time between two pieces. It is allowed to play the same pieces in both the preliminary round and in the final round.

**Category young talents up to and including 13 year-olds:**

**Online preliminary round:**

Choose one of the following pieces for flute and piano:

Gabriel Fauré, Berceuse

Franz Danzi, Sonatine in D major

And a piece for flute solo of your own choice. It is allowed to choose a piece for flute solo from the list of compulsory pieces for the final round.

**Live final round:**

A piece, or part(s) of it, for flute and piano of your own choice. It is allowed to choose a piece for flute and piano from the list of compulsory pieces for the preliminary round.

And choose one of the following solo pieces:

Marius Flothuis, Aubade

Georg Philipp Telemann, Fantasie nr.4

**Category young talents age 14 up to and including 18 year-olds:**

**Online preliminary round:**

Choose one of the following pieces for flute and piano:

Gabriel Fauré, Sicilienne

Josef Rheinberger, Rhapsodie

And a piece for flute solo of your own choice. It is allowed to choose a piece for flute solo from the list of compulsory pieces for the final round.

**Live final round:**

A piece, or part(s) of it, for flute and piano of your own choice. It is allowed to choose a piece for flute and piano from the list of compulsory pieces for the preliminary round.

And choose one of the following solo pieces:

Eugène Bozza, Image

Astor Piazzolla, Tango-Etude for Flute, nr.3

Piccolo players play a compulsory piece for piccolo and piano and a compulsory piece for piccolo solo in the preliminary round and another compulsory piece for piccolo and piano and a compulsory piece for piccolo solo in the final round.
